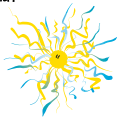
(Kids, please note: this is the only page that officially pays attention to adults. After this page, it's all yours!)

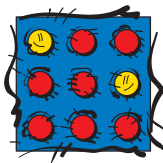

APRIL



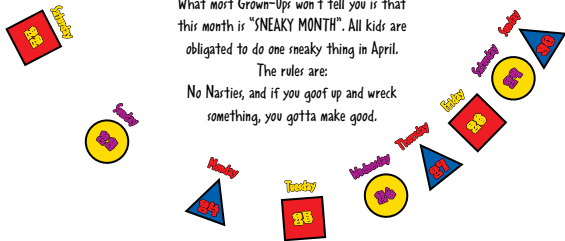
April is usually still a cold month.

Warm this town up!

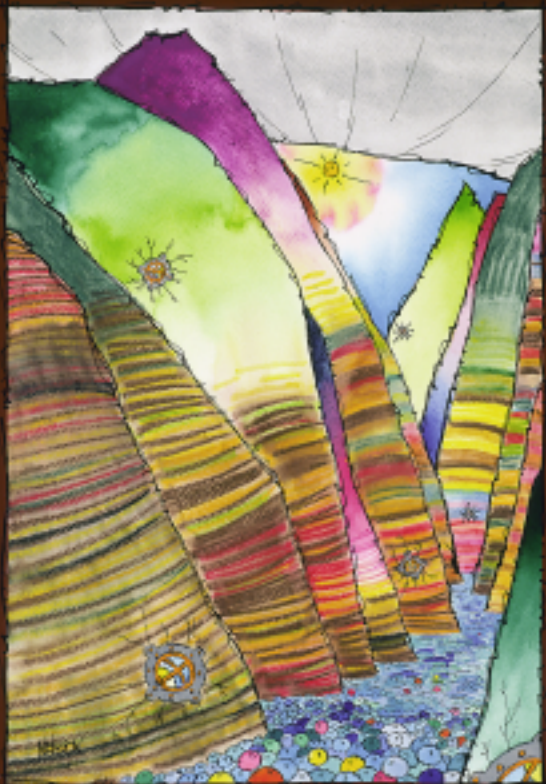


April of course, starts with April Fools Day.

The ruler are:

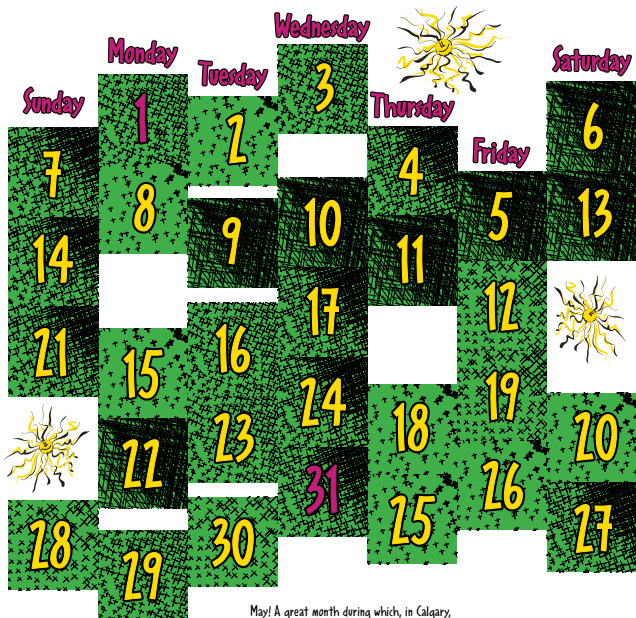

MAY



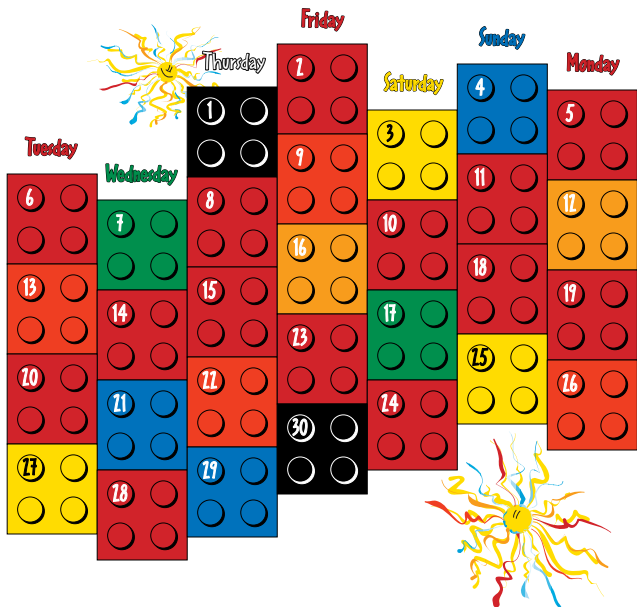

The Days aren't necessarily in a traditional order though...



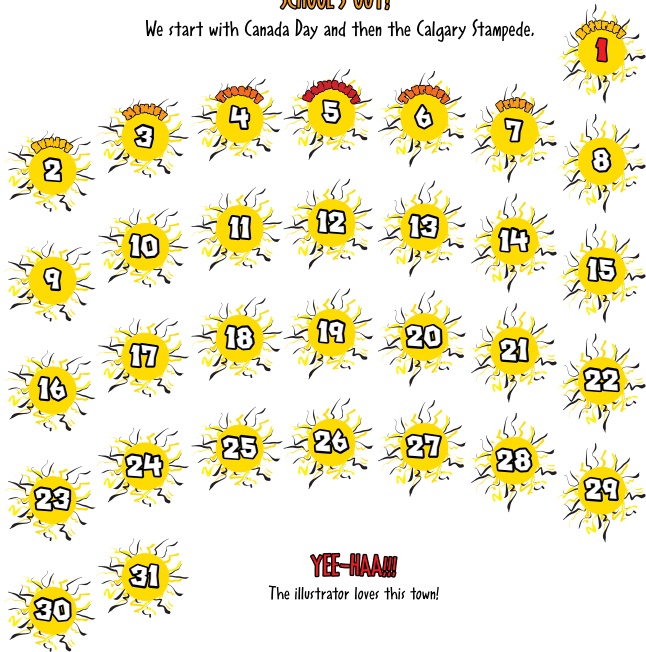


Triangles out the ying-yang too

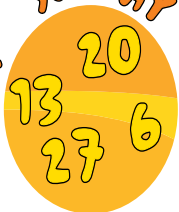

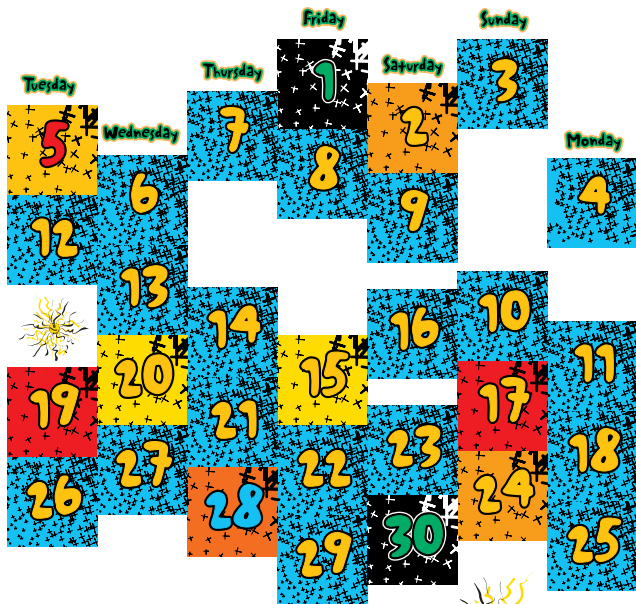

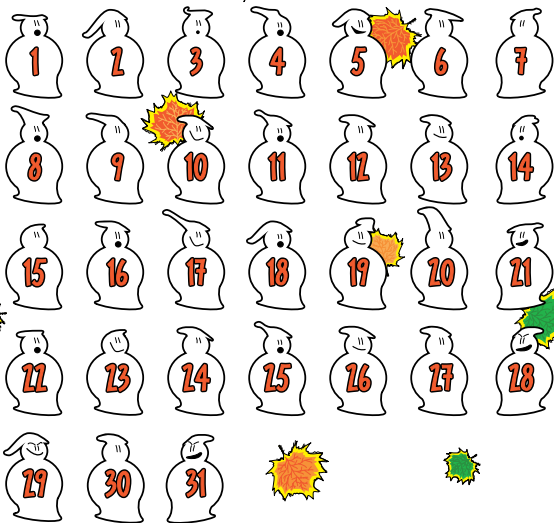


Clown Bubbles group portrait

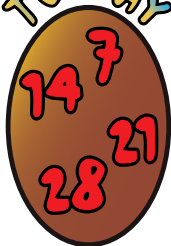
